Willow bark has been used for pain relief at daily doses of 1 to 3 g of bark, which corresponds to salicin 60 to 120 mg. A clinical study of patients with lower back pain used willow bark at a dose of salicin 120 to 240 mg/day. A proprietary extract of willow bark, Assalix, was standardized to contain 15% salicin.
